<b>Juvenile Division:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>One DSO at Barry J. Nidorf Juvenile Hall tested positive in the last 24 hours. Individual is asymptomatic.</li> <li>There were five additional DSOs that were potentially exposed and will be self-monitoring for 14 days. Additionally, the 17 youth that were potentially exposed will be quarantined for 14 days (until 4/29).</li> <li>No youth are exhibiting any symptoms or illness. All of the DSOs were wearing masks during the potential exposure.</li> <li>Masks are now available to all youth in juvenile facilities.</li> </ul>
