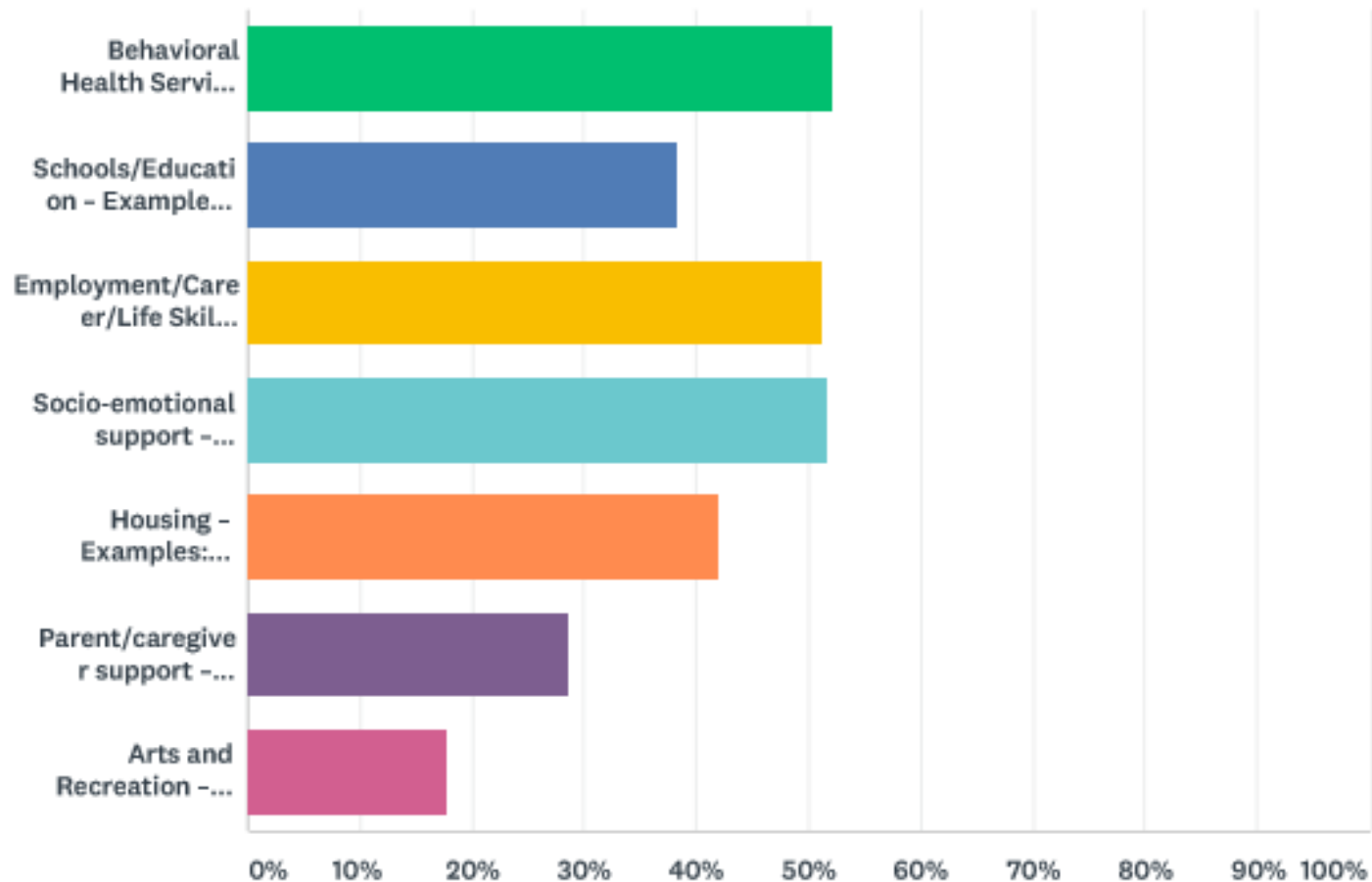

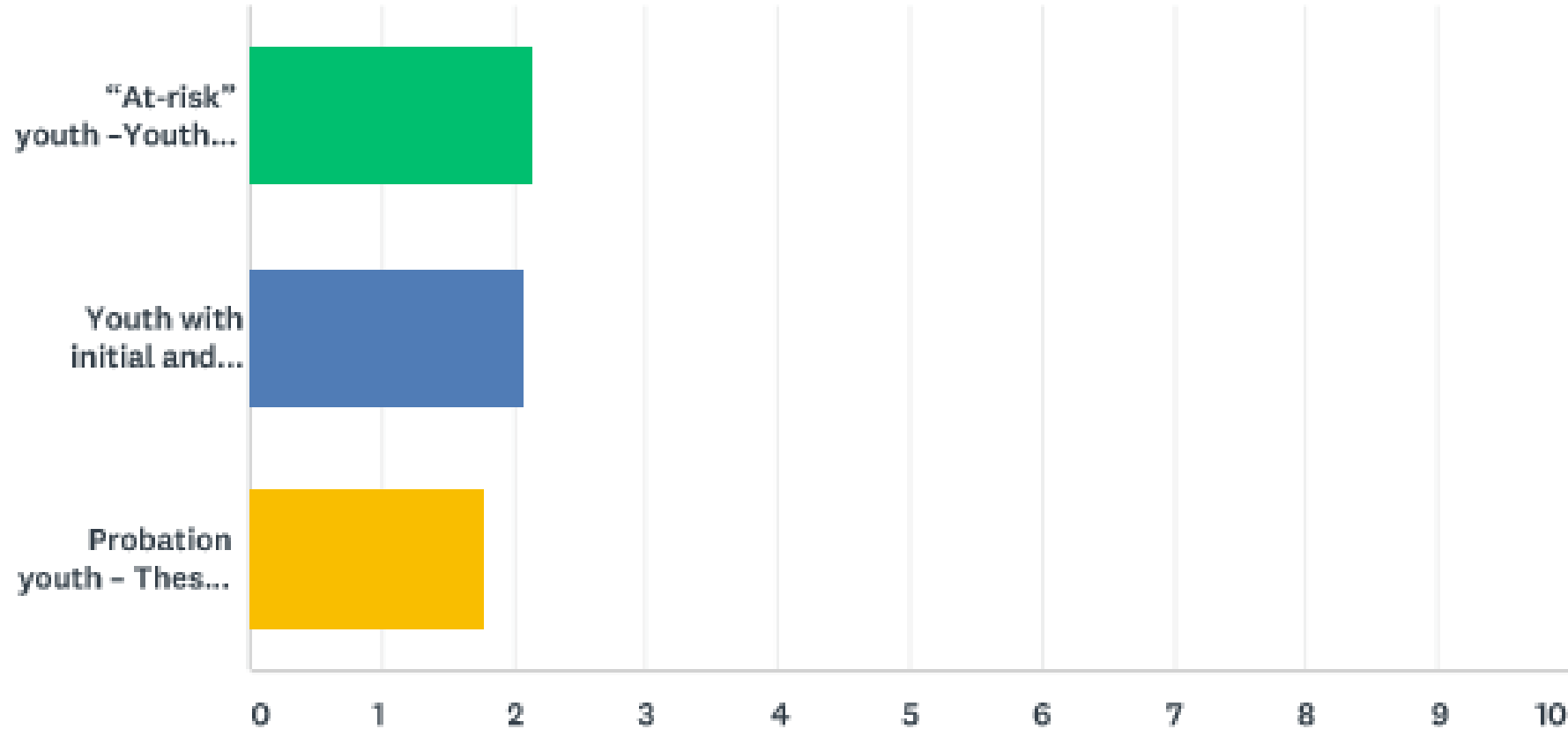

What category of services do you feel are most in need of funding for youth in the County of Los Angeles based on the greatest unfulfilled need?



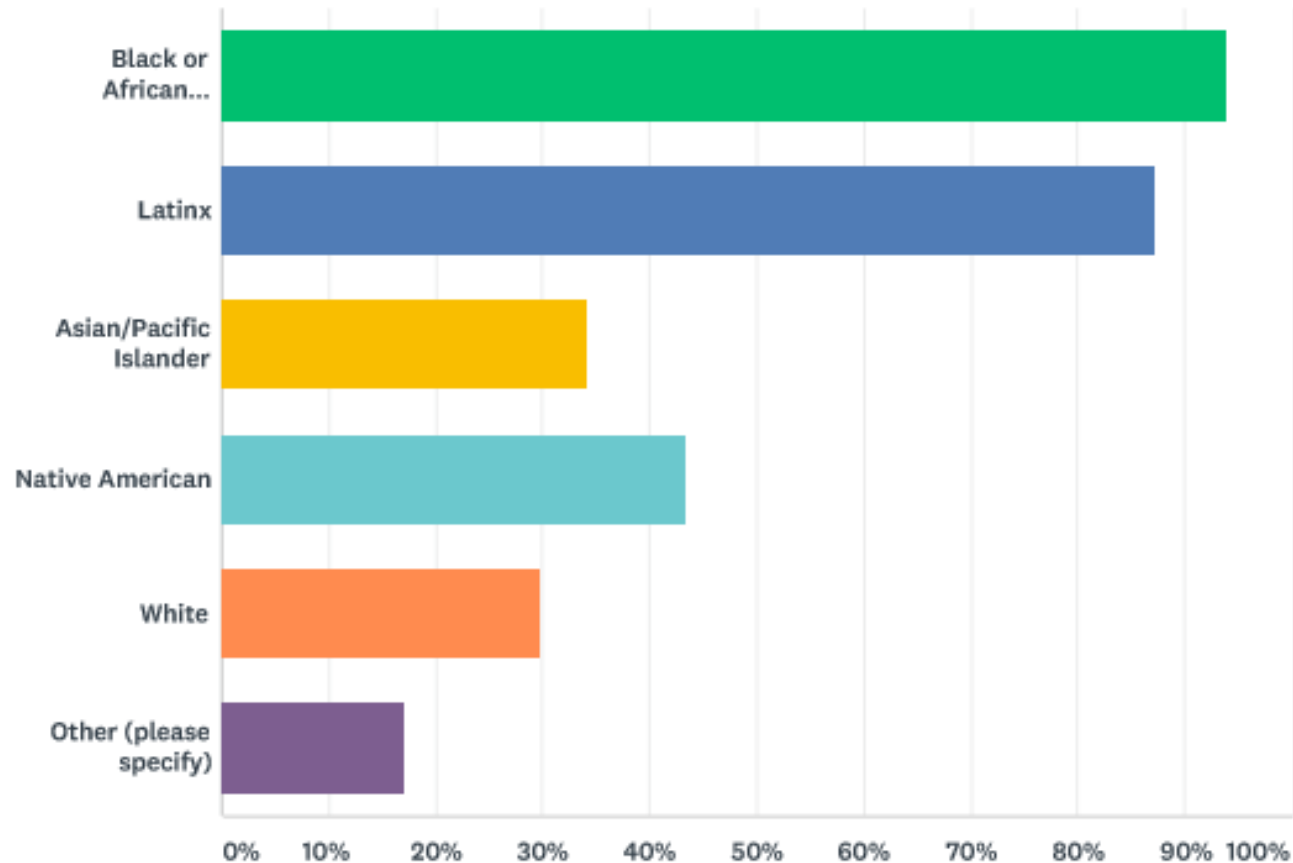

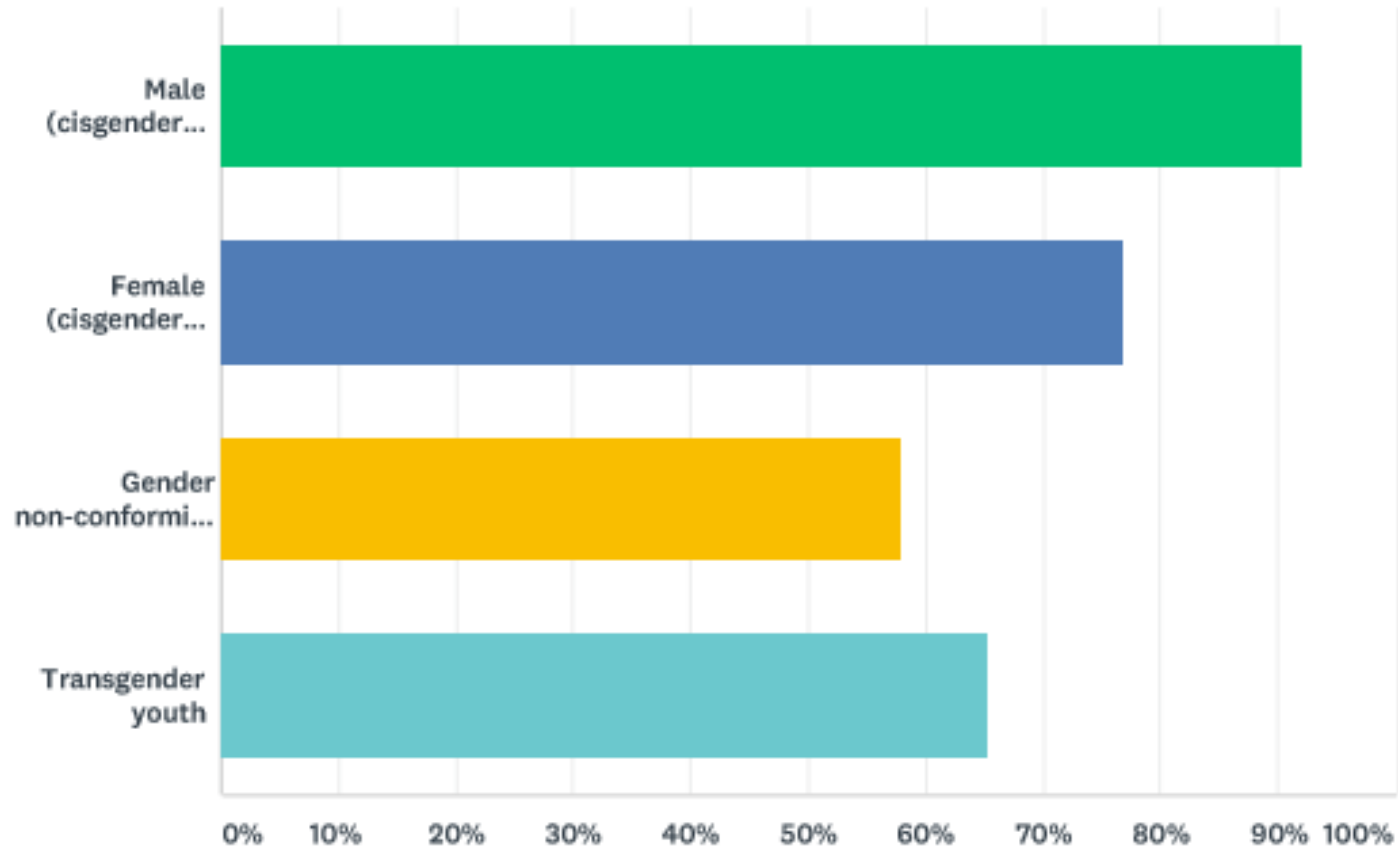
Which category of youth do you feel are in most need of these services? Race/Ethnicity

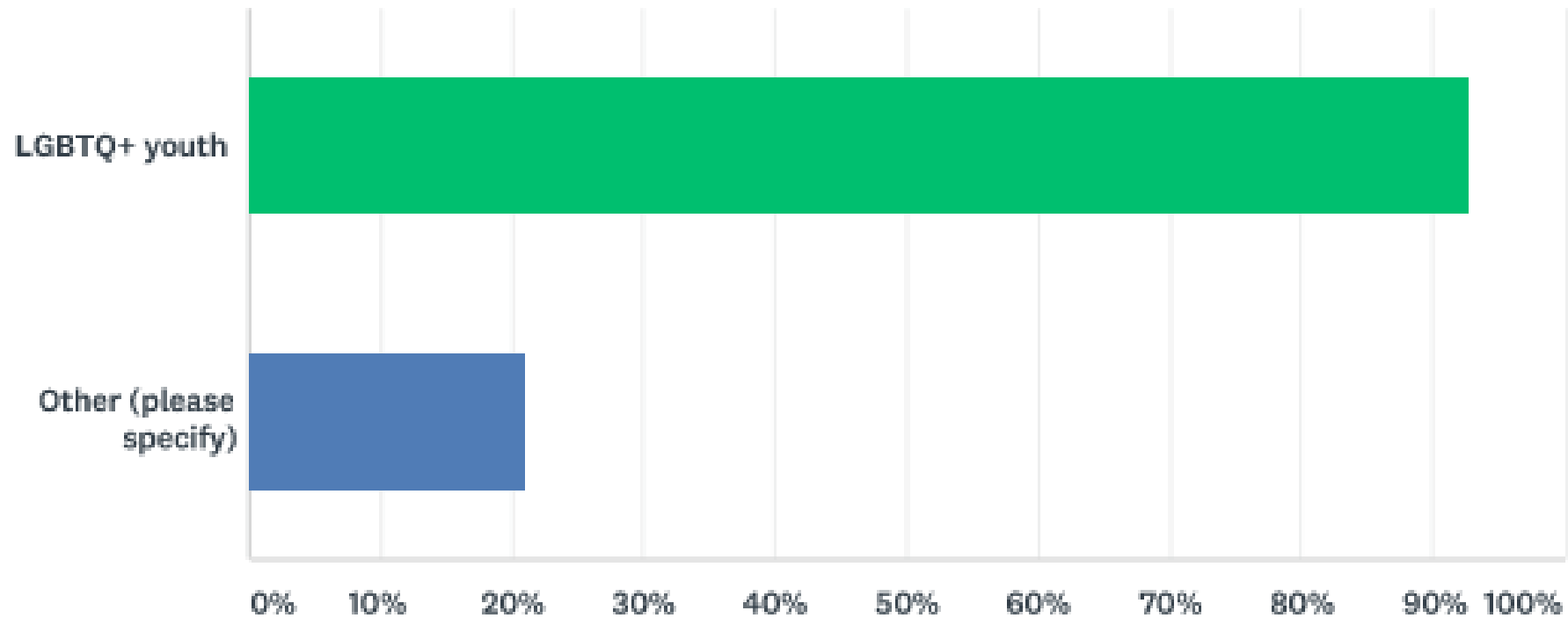
Which category of youth do you feel are in most need of these services? Gender

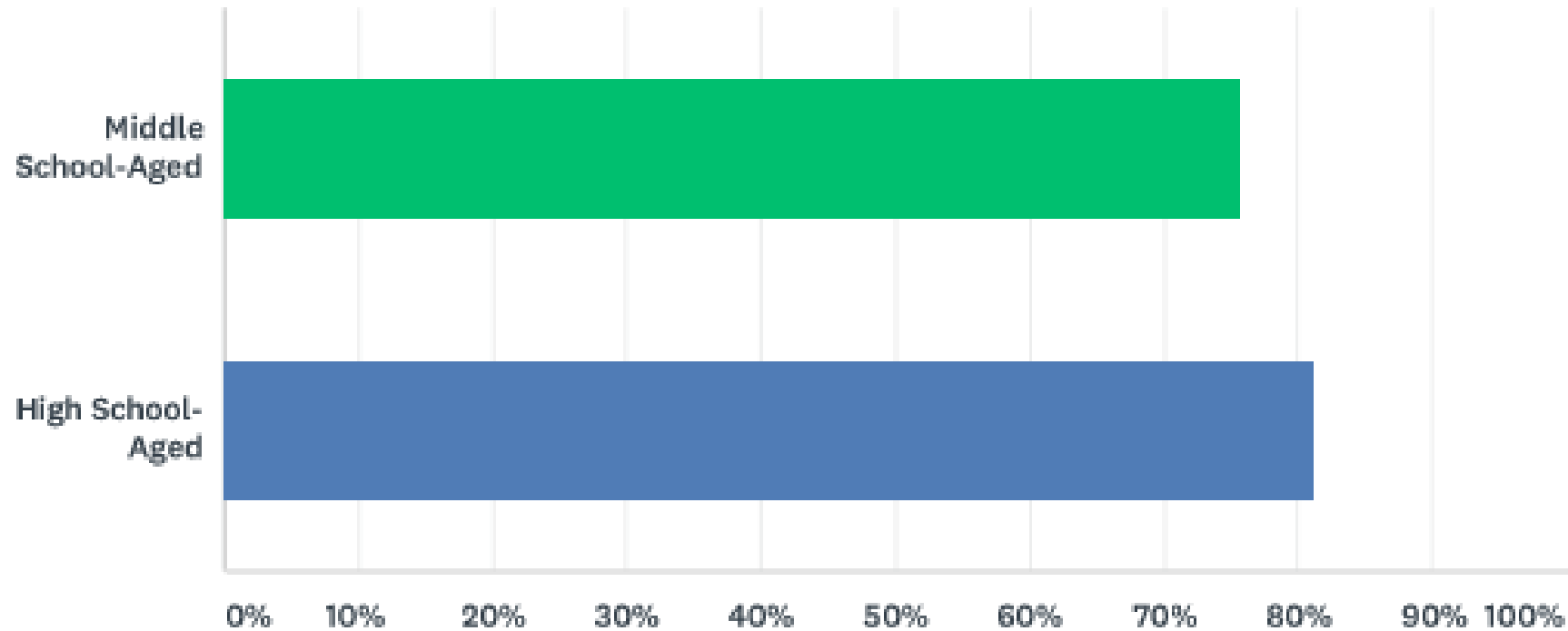
Which category of youth do you feel are in most need of these services? Sexual Orientation

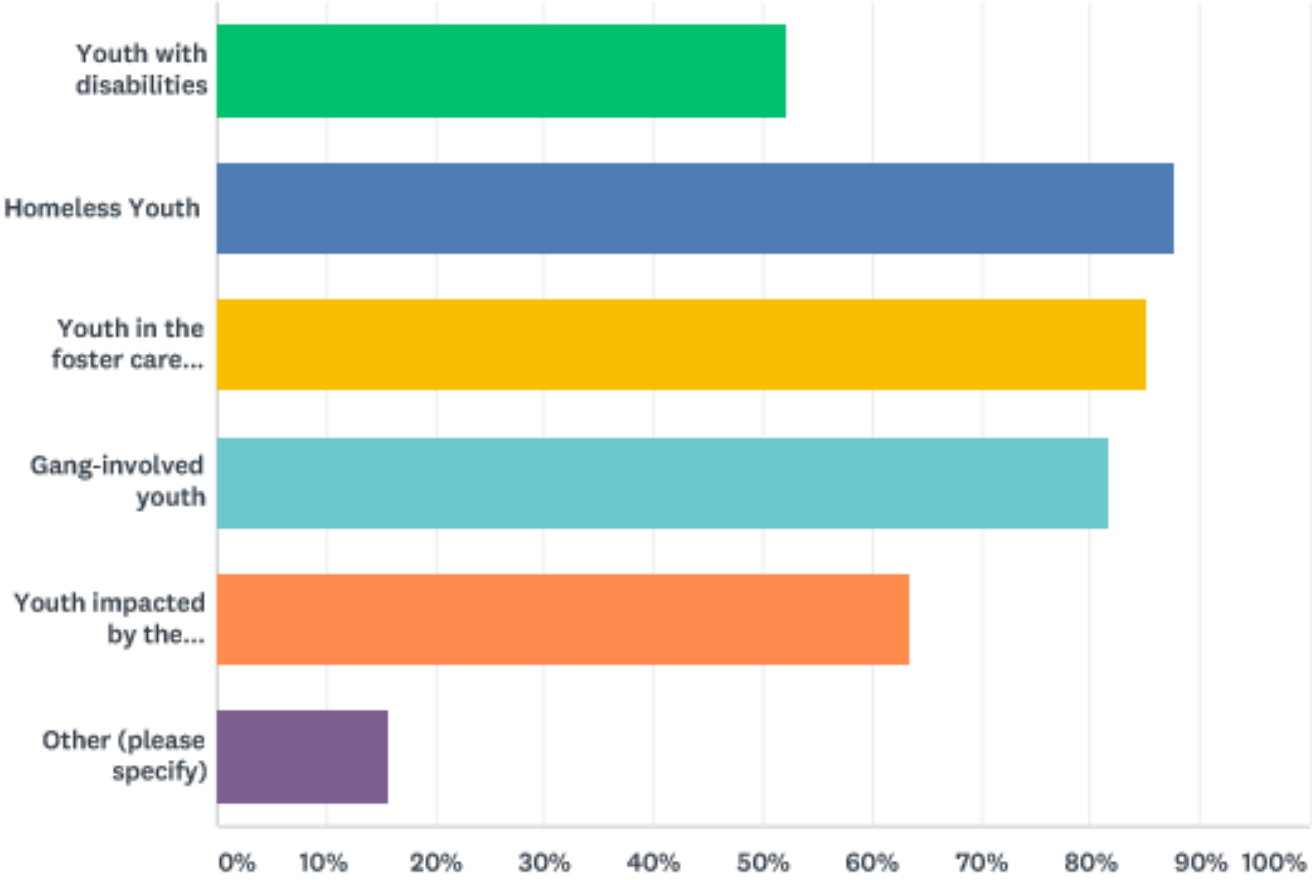

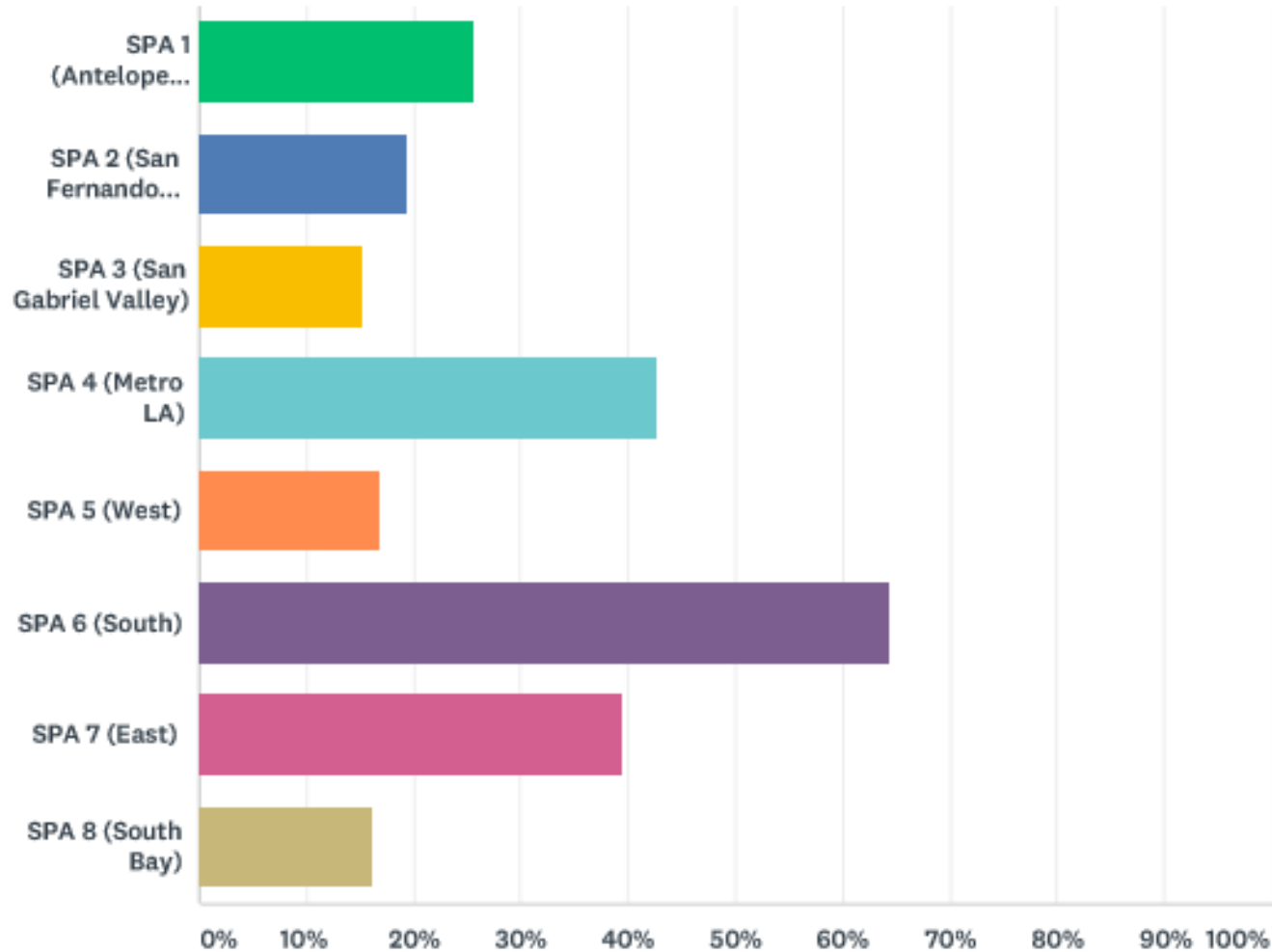

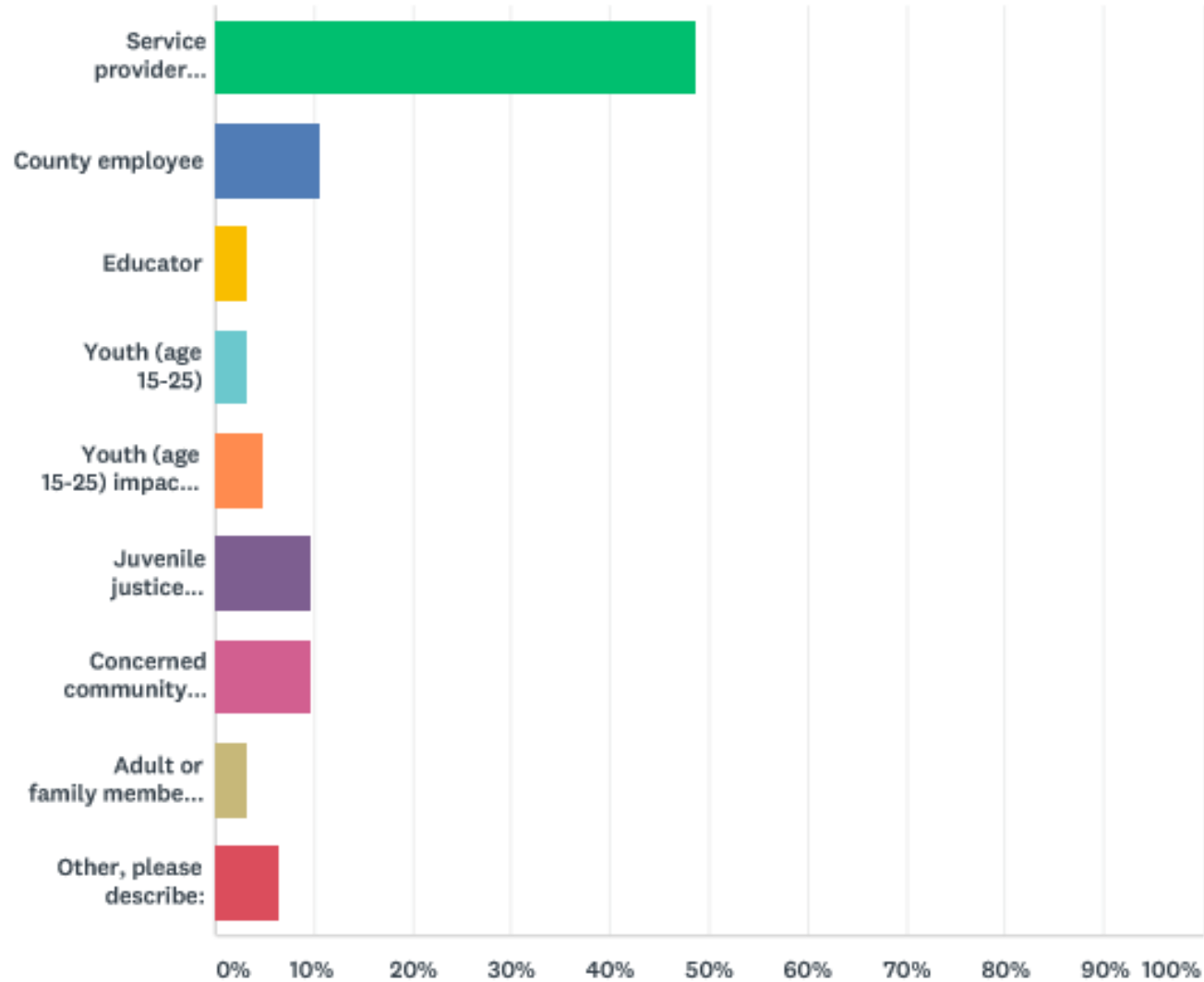
Which geographic area, as defined by county Service Planning Areas (SPAs), do you feel is in highest need of this programming or services?

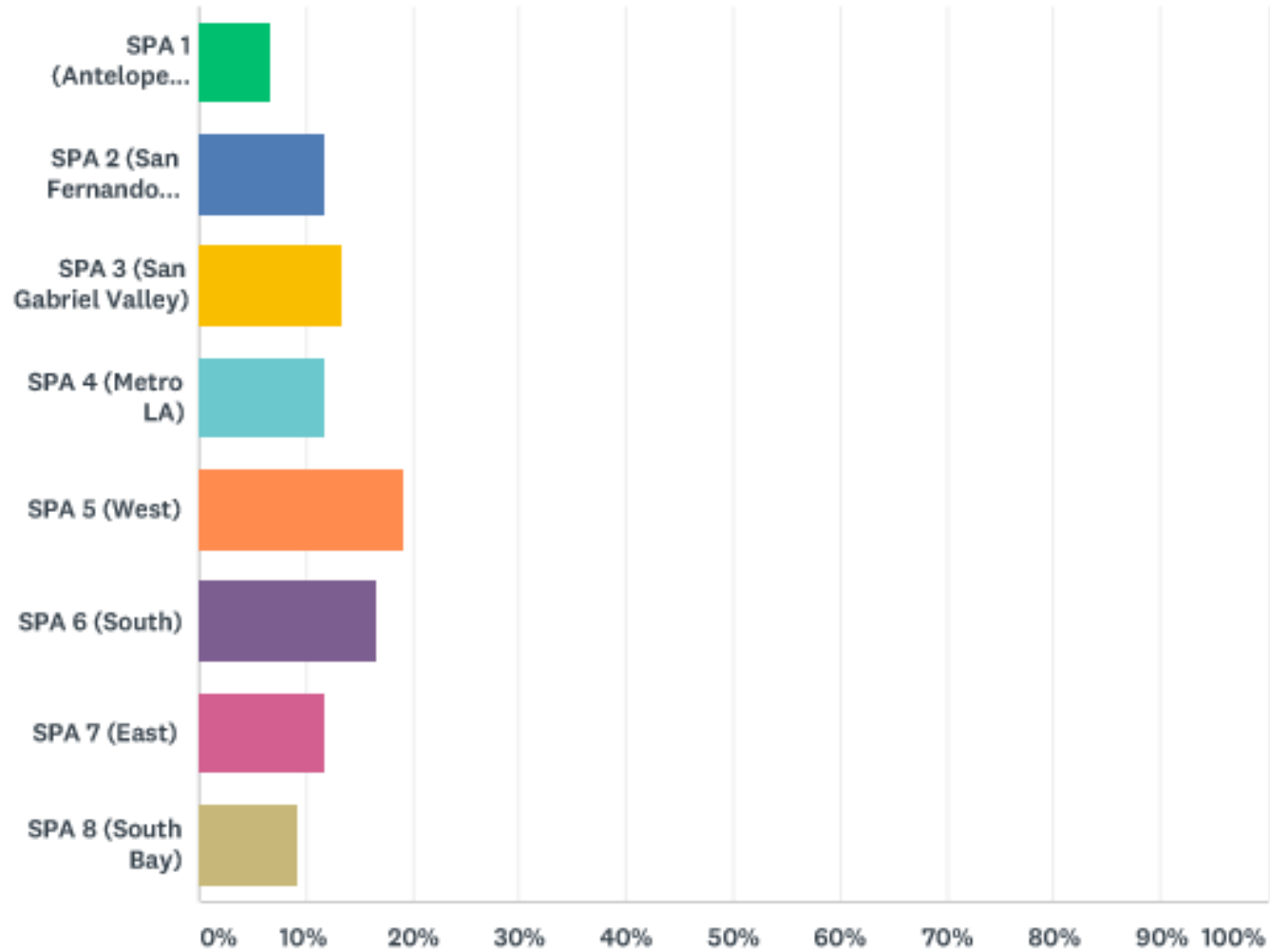
What best describes you? (Respondent)

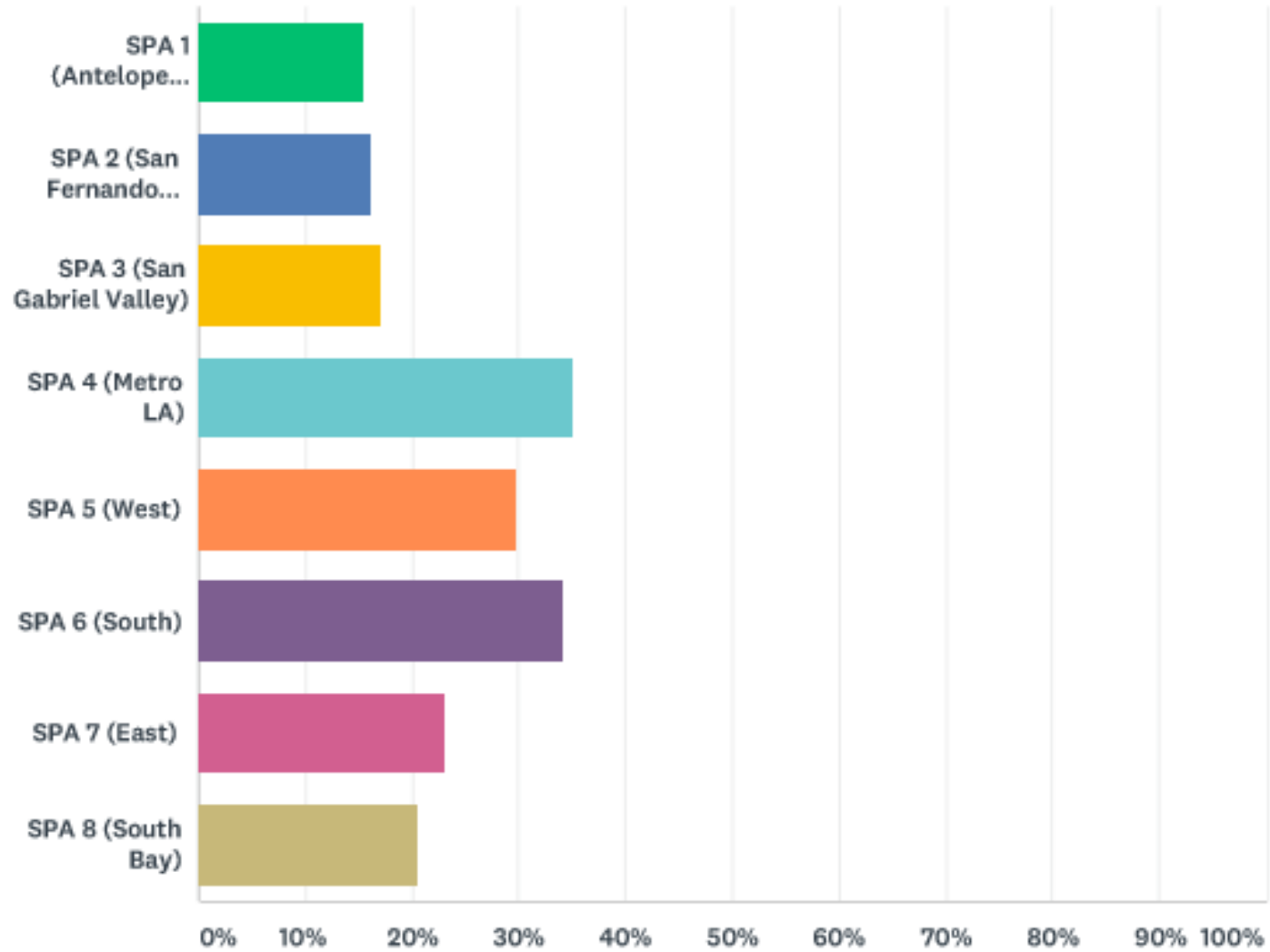
What Service Planning Area (SPA) do you live in? (Respondent)

Needs Assessment Takeaways

- No major differences between survey rounds 1 and 2
