QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS**

<b>1.</b>	<b>Question</b>	This statement in the RFP (page 1, Item 1.1) suggests there will only be one award: "this Request for Proposals (RFP) to solicit proposals for a Contract with an organization that can provide Comprehensive Services to the Assembly Bill 109 (hereinafter "AB 109") population. Is this the case that there will only be one award?
	<b>Answer</b>	<b>Yes. Only one contract will be awarded.</b>
<b>2.</b>	<b>Question</b>	Must a contractor actually operate a housing facility and provide services to this population or may a potential contractor provide services to residents in housing facilities operated by others?
	<b>Answer</b>	<b>Please refer to RFP, Section 3, Proposer's Minimum Mandatory Qualifications, pages 2-3.</b>
