NARRATIVE:

Andreanna Dammeier has an extensive adult criminal history that began at the age of 18. Her convictions include: assault, contempt of court, possession of controlled substance, trespass, suspended license, failure to appear, and drive with .08% blood alcohol content. She has served multiple state prison terms, the longest being a two hundred sixty eight day prison term for contempt of court. Dammeier was released from state prison to the supervision of the Los Angeles County Probation Department on 12/24/2023. Under the Governor's Public Safety Realignment Act of 2011, better known as Assembly Bill 109 (AB 109) the responsibility of lower-level offenders was shifted from the State to Los Angeles County. She subsequently failed to report to her probation officer and an arrest warrant was issued in February 2024 after she absconded from post release community supervision (PRCS). Dammeier qualified to be released to the supervision of probation, under AB 109, because her current commitment offense for assault is defined as non-serious and non-violent under the California penal code. Her criminal history, and current failure to comply with the terms of release make her a most wanted. If you know her whereabouts please contact...
