NARRATIVE:

Wendy Ramirez is a documented gang member and has an extensive adult criminal history that began at the age of 18. Her convictions include: possession of controlled substance, knife weapons violation, battery of peace officer, grand theft auto, vehicle theft, trespass, tamper with vehicle, burglary, drive with .08% blood alcohol content, suspended license, battery, disorderly conduct, drive under the influence of drugs/alcohol, and petty theft. She has served multiple state prison terms, the longest being a thirty-two month prison term for knife weapons violation and grand theft auto. Ramirez was released from state prison to the supervision of the Los Angeles County Probation Department on 01/23/2017. Under the Governor's Public Safety Realignment Act of 2011, better known as Assembly Bill 109 (AB 109) the responsibility of lower-level offenders was shifted from the State to Los Angeles County. She subsequently failed to report to her probation officer and an arrest warrant was issued in April 2019 after she absconded from post release community supervision (PRCS). Ramirez qualified to be released to the supervision of probation, under AB 109, because her current commitment offense for knife weapons violation is defined as non-serious and non-violent under the California penal code. Her criminal history, gang member status and current failure to comply with the terms of release make her a most wanted. If you know her whereabouts please contact...
