SUBJECT: IMMEDIATE MODIFICATION TO DIRECTIVE NUMBER 788 "SEXUAL OFFENDER EMPLOYMENT AND RESIDENCE NOTIFICATION AND MANDATED LIFETIME REGISTRATION"

Effective immediately, the requirement that written notification be given to employers and volunteer programs, regarding the status of convicted sexual offenders, has been rescinded. Los Angeles County Probation Department staff shall not make the notification, as outlined in Directive Number 788, to employers and/or volunteer programs.

MANDATED LIFETIME REGISTRATION

Directive Number 788 also addresses "mandated lifetime registration." All procedures, regarding sex offender registration, remain in place. Registration is mandatory, per Penal Code (PC) Section 290(a). Persons required to register as sex offenders, shall do so each year, within five days before or after their birthday, and within five days of changing his or her address or name. Sex offenders having no address are required to update their registration no less than every 90 days.

FURTHER REVISIONS TO DIRECTIVE NUMBER 788 ARE PENDING

These issues and others, as outlined in Directive Number 788, are being reviewed and revised instructions will be issued in a forthcoming Directive.
