SUBJECT: REGISTRATION OF SEX, ARSON, AND NARCOTICS OFFENDERS WHO ARE CURRENTLY ON ELECTRONIC MONITORING OR IN WORK FURLOUGH

Probationers who have been convicted of an offense requiring registration per PC290 (Sex Offenders,) PC457.1 (Arson Offenders,) or HS11590 (Narcotics Offenders,) and who are participating in Electronic Monitoring or Work Furlough are required to register upon release from jail, even though they are serving jail time in a community-based program. A change of address after completion of the program may dictate subsequent re-registration.

Sex Offender Registration

According to **Adult Manual Section 2200**, if the probationer is required to register pursuant to PC290, then the DPO will "instruct the probationer to register with the police agency having jurisdiction over the area in which the probationer resides and return within six (6) working days with proof of registration."

Probationers participating in the Electronic Monitoring Program or the Work Furlough Program are not exempt from this policy. Therefore, these probationers will be required to register with the local police agency, (even if temporarily,) while involved in these programs. Once the program is completed, the probationer will be required to register again and provide the updated address information to the police agency if necessary.

Narcotic Offender Registration

Per **Adult Manual Section 304**, the probationer will have ten (10) days to provide proof of registration to the DPO. Those probationers involved in the Electronic Monitoring or Work Furlough programs are not exempt from registration requirements. They will need to register with the police agency having jurisdiction over the area of residence. When the probationer is released from Electronic Monitoring or Work Furlough, s/he will need to register again and provide updated address information if necessary.

Arson Registration

Per **Adult Manual Section 305**, a probationer must register if convicted of PC451 (Arson causing GBI) or PC453 (Possession/Manufacture of incendiary Device.) The probationer will be required to register within 30 days of coming into the city or county. This includes probationers serving a jail sentence in the community, through Electronic Monitoring and/or Work Furlough. The probationer will need to register and provide proof to the DPO. The probationer will subsequently be required to re-register upon completion of Electronic Monitoring or Work Furlough if his/her place of residence changes as a result.
