

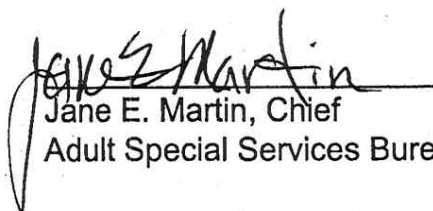

SUBJECT: BENCH WARRANT PROCEDURE ON PROPOSITION 36 CASES
"MODIFICATION OF DIRECTIVE 911"

Effective immediately, when a bench warrant is issued on a Proposition 36 cases, and after all procedural matters are completed by the DPO and SDPO, the file is to be submitted to Clerical. Clerical is to immediately enter warrant data into APS and transfer the case to the in-house 88B caseload. The file is to remain in the office for 30 days, as Proposition 36 defendants quite often return to court during that time period. After those 30 days, and if there is no notification that the defendant has appeared in court or the bench warrant recalled, the file is to be sent to the area office servicing the court that issued the warrant. The area office will retain the file until the case requires further action.
