SUBJECT: PROCEDURES FOR FILING THE "NOTICE OF SEX OFFENDER REGISTRATION REQUIREMENT – 290 PC", "NOTICE OF ARSON OFFENDER REGISTRATION REQUIREMENT – 457.1 PC", AND "NOTICE OF NARCOTIC OFFENDER REGISTRATION – 11590 H&S"

This Directive is to provide information regarding State law as it pertains to registration requirements for adult probationers that are convicted of specified crimes that fall under Penal Code sections 290 PC and 457.1 PC (see attachments A & B regarding applicable sex and arson crimes), and 11590 H & S. One or more of the forms (depending on the conviction(s)) must be completed on each probationer that fall under the law (see attachments C, D, and E). If it is determined that a probationer should have already been registered, and that information is not available or confirmed, then that person must also be provided with the form(s) and ordered to register.

SIT AND CASC DPO RESPONSIBILITIES

The SIT or CASC Deputy Probation Officer will be responsible for ensuring the form is completed and distributed on each new case or if it cannot be verified that the probationer was registered from a previous conviction. **In all instances, the DPO shall enter data in DCID regarding the notification provided to the probationer and that copies were distributed.** Distribution is as follows:

FOR SEX AND ARSON CONVICTIONS

1. The original must be sent to the Department of Justice at the following address:

2. A copy shall be immediately sent to the law enforcement agency having jurisdiction over the probationer's address.
3. A copy shall be placed in the probationer's X file.

4. A copy shall be provided to the probationer.
5. A copy shall be provided to the Deputy District Attorney's Office at the court site where the probationer was granted probation.

FOR NARCOTIC REGISTRATION

1. The original shall be immediately sent to the law enforcement agency having jurisdiction over the probationer's address.
2. A copy shall be placed in the probationer's X file.
3. A copy shall be provided to the probationer.
4. A copy shall be provided to the Deputy District Attorney's Office at the court site where the probationer was granted probation.

DPO OF RECORD RESPONSIBILITIES

The DPO of record is responsible for ensuring ongoing registration as required.

FOR SEX OFFENDER REGISTRATION

1. The probationer must register within five working days of release from incarceration, placement, or commitment on any offense, with the law enforcement agency having jurisdiction over her/his place of residence or where s/he is physically present as a transient.
2. The probationer must annual update their registration information within five working days of their birthday, at the law enforcement agency having jurisdiction over her/his residence or where s/he is currently present as a transient.
3. The probationer must register upon coming into, or when changing her/his address within a city and/or county in which s/he is residing and must register in person within five working days with the law enforcement agency having jurisdiction over her/his residence.
4. If the probationer changes her/his registration address to a new address, either within the same jurisdiction, or anywhere inside or outside of the state, s/he must

inform the last registering agency or agencies in person within five working days before s/he leaves. If the new address is unknown, s/he must notify, by registered or certified mail, the last registering agency or agencies of the new address or transient location within five working days of moving to the new address or location.

5. If the probationer is registered at a residence address and becomes transient or if registered as a transient and s/he moves to a residence, s/he has five working days in which to register with the law enforcement agency having jurisdiction over the new address or transient location.
6. If the probationer has no residence address, s/he must register in the jurisdiction where s/he is physically present as a transient within five working days of becoming transient. Thereafter, s/he must update their registration information no less than once every 30 days with the law enforcement agency having jurisdiction over the place where s/he is physically present as a transient. S/he does not need to report changes of transient location within the 30-day period unless s/he moves out of state. The probationer must still comply with the annual requirement to update her/his registration.
7. If the probationer is registered as a transient and moving out of state, s/he must inform the agency having jurisdiction over the place where s/he was physically present as a transient, in person, within five working days before s/he leaves. S/he must also inform the agency of her/his planned destination, residence or transient location out of state, if known, and any plans to return to California.
8. If s/he moves outside of California, s/he must register in the new state according to the arriving states sex offender registration requirements.
9. If the probationer was ever convicted as a sexually violent predator, s/he must update her/his registration information no less than once every 90 days with the law enforcement agency having jurisdiction over her/his residence or transient location. S/he must also comply with the annual requirement to update her/his registration.
10. If the probationer has more than one residence address at which s/he regularly reside (regardless of the number of days or nights s/he spends at each address), s/he must register at all of the addresses with the law enforcement agency or agencies having jurisdiction over these residences.

11. If the probationer resides or is a transient on a University of California, California State University, or community college campus, s/he must register within five working days with the local law enforcement agency having jurisdiction over the campus, and additionally with the campus police.
12. If the probationer is enrolled or employed (with or without compensation), at an institution of higher learning, s/he must register within five working days of commencement of the term of enrollment or employment, with the campus police department or, if no campus police department exists, with the law enforcement agency having jurisdiction over that campus. S/he must also register with the law enforcement agency having jurisdiction over her/his place of residence or transient location. When the probation ceases being enrolled or employed at that institution, s/he must notify the registering agency within five working days.
13. If the probationer resides outside of California, and s/he is required to register in that state, and s/he is attending school or employed in California, s/he must register with the law enforcement agency having jurisdiction over the school or employment location, in addition to register in her/his state of residence.
14. The probationer must provide proof of residence to the registering agency within 30 days of registration or re-registration at a new residence address.
15. If the probationer is on parole or probation, s/he must provide proof of registration to her/his parole agent or probation officer within six working days of release on parole or probation and proof of any change or update to her/his registration within five working days.
16. If the probationer changes her/his name, s/he must notify, within five working days, the law enforcement agency or agencies having jurisdiction over her/his place of residence or place where s/he is required to register as a transient.

NOTE: The probationer must submit to DNA samples, as well as fingerprints and full palm prints.

FOR ARSON REGISTRATION

1. The probationer must register as an adult arson offender as a lifetime requirement,

or if the offender is a juvenile, until age 25.

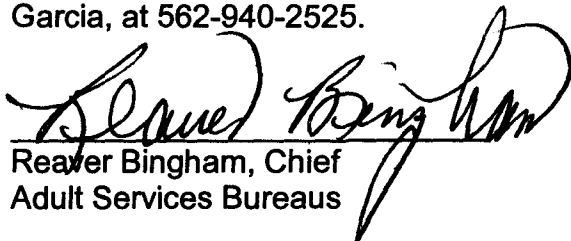
2. The probationer must register within 14 working days of coming into any city, county, or city and county in which s/he is located or resides with the law enforcement agency having jurisdiction over her/his location or place of residence.
3. Upon any change of location or place of residence, the probationer must inform, in writing within ten working days, the law enforcement agency with which s/he last registered.

NOTE: The probation is required to submit DNA samples, as well as fingerprints and full palm prints.

FOR NARCOTIC REGISTRATION

1. The probationer must register within 30 days of coming into any county or city or city and county in which s/he is located or resides with the law enforcement agency having jurisdiction over her/his location or place of residence.
2. The probationer must, upon changing her/his location or place of residence, inform in writing within ten working days the law enforcement agency with which s/he last registered.
3. If the probationer was convicted in any other state court or federal court, s/he is required to register under the provisions above.
4. The probationer must register as a narcotics offender for five years after discharge from prison, release from jail, or expiration of parole or probation.

For the below section, sex offender is required to: 1) read and initial all requirements; 2) sign and date; and 3) provide thumbprint.

I have been notified of my duty to register as a sex offender pursuant to sections 290 and 290.01 of the California Penal Code (PC). I understand it is my duty to know the legal requirements as stated in 290 PC and 290.01 PC, including changes to the law which may be made in the future. These requirements include, but are not limited to the following:

- My responsibility to register as a sex offender is a lifetime requirement.
- I must register or re-register, if I have previously registered, within five (5) working days of release from incarceration, placement, or commitment on any offense, with the law enforcement agency having jurisdiction over my place(s) of residence or where I am physically present as a transient.
- I must annually update my registration information, within five (5) working days of my birthday, at the law enforcement agency having jurisdiction over my residence address or where I am currently present as a transient. Annual updates begin with my first birthday following registration or change of address.
- Upon coming into, or when changing my residence address within a city and/or county in which I am residing, I must register or re-register in person within five (5) working days as a sex offender with the law enforcement agency having jurisdiction over my residence.
- If I change my registered address to a new address, either within the same jurisdiction, or anywhere inside or outside of the state, I must inform the last registering agency or agencies in person within five (5) working days before I leave. If I do not know my new residence address, I must later notify, by registered or certified mail, the last registering agency or agencies of the new address or transient location within five (5) working days of moving to the new address or location.
- If I am registered at a residence address and become transient or if I am registered as a transient and move to a residence, I shall have five (5) working days within which to register with the law enforcement agency having jurisdiction over the new address or transient location.
- If I have no residence address, I must register in the jurisdiction where I am physically present as a transient within five (5) working days of becoming transient. Thereafter, I must update my registration information no less than once every 30 days with the law enforcement agency having jurisdiction over the place where I am physically present as a transient. I do not need to report changes of transient location within the 30-day period unless I move out of state. I must also comply with the annual requirement to update my registration.
- If I am registered as a transient and I am moving out of state, I must inform the agency having jurisdiction over the place where I was physically present as a transient, in person, within five (5) working days before I leave. I must also inform the agency of my planned destination, residence or transient location out of state, if known, and any plans to return to California.
- If I move outside of California, I am required to register in the new state within ten (10) working days.
- If I have ever been committed as a sexually violent predator, I must update my registration information no less than once every 90 days with the law enforcement agency having jurisdiction over my residence or transient location. I must also comply with the annual requirement to update my registration.
- If I have more than one residence address at which I regularly reside (regardless of the number of days or nights I spend at each address), I must register all of the addresses with the law enforcement agency or agencies having jurisdiction over these residences.
