SUBJECT: ADULT PROBATIONER DNA COLLECTIONS

Effective January 1, 2009, State, County, and Municipal Law Enforcement Agencies were mandated, pursuant to PC 298(a)(2)(C), to collect DNA samples from all adults arrested for any felony offense. This expansion of the DNA collection requirements is not retroactive for arrests that occurred prior to **January 1, 2009.**

The Probation Department remains responsible for the collection and submission of DNA samples for adult probationers convicted of a felony when the arrest occurred prior to January 1, 2009. Deputies are to review their area office listing of "Defendants with Blank DNA Indicator" (APS Report) and check the "DFID" screen to identify those probationers needing immediate review and/or referral. Deputies should instruct affected adult felony probationers to contact the Probation Information Center (PIC) @ (866) 931-2222 to schedule an appointment at one of the following locations for DNA sample collection:

NO EARLY TERMINATION OF PROBATION CAN BE RECOMMENDED WITHOUT FIRST CONFIRMING A DNA SAMPLE HAS BEEN TAKEN, SUBMITTED AND RECORDED. (Deputies must verify this through CRIMINAL RECORD CLEARANCES: CCHRS, etc.)

PLEASE NOTE: ONLY PROBATIONERS WITH A FELONY OFFENSE OCCURRING AFTER JANUARY 1, 2009 ARE TO BE REFERRED BACK TO THE ARRESTING LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY FOR DNA SAMPLE COLLECTION.
