SUBJECT: BLUE DENIM DAYS

This Directive amends Directives #1101 (Training Guidelines and Expectations), #1113 (Staff Dress Code and Grooming Standard) and #1122 (Probation Department Uniform Policy).

Trainees may wear neat, appropriately laundered, and correctly sized blue denim pants on designated days for specific events (e.g., March of Dimes Campaign) when upheld by a motion by the Board of Supervisors and/or when approved by the Chief Probation Officer or Chief Deputy on designated days for specific events (e.g., Probation fundraisers). All other articles of clothing and shoes must comply with the existing Training Guidelines and Expectations Dress Code policy.

Non supervisory staff, supervisors and managers may wear neat, appropriately laundered, and correctly sized blue denim pants on designated days for specific events (e.g., March of Dimes Campaign) when upheld by a motion by the Board of Supervisors and/or when approved by the Chief Probation Officer or Chief Deputy on designated days for specific events (e.g., Probation fundraisers). All other articles of clothing and shoes must comply with the existing Staff Dress Code policy.

Sworn staff working in the juvenile halls, camps and the Transportation section that must wear the approved and official Class "B" uniform may wear neat, appropriately laundered, and correctly sized blue denim pants on designated days for specific events (e.g. March of Dimes Campaign) when upheld by a motion by the Board of Supervisors and/or when approved by the Chief Probation Officer or Chief Deputy on designated days for specific events (e.g., Probation fundraisers). All other articles of clothing and shoes must comply with the Class "B" Uniform Policy.

Employees required to appear in court must dress in business attire consistent with the formal atmosphere of the judicial environment regardless of the motion by the Board of Supervisors and/or approval by the Chief Probation Officer or Chief Deputy.

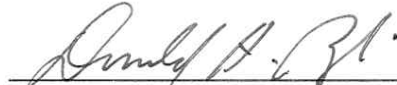
Prohibited Denim Clothing

- Denim pants of any color other than blue
- Denim with holes
- Cutoffs
- Capri pants
- Shorts
- Shirts
- Skirts
- Dresses
- Jackets

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- Vests
- Blue denim pants printed with graphics (clothing graphics and artwork, such as silk-screening, designer labels, or embroidery, are restricted to Probation Department approved logos, or small unobtrusive clothing designer labels)
