SUBJECT: Static 99R: State Authorized Risk Assessment Tool for Adult Male Sex Offenders

Every adult male required to register as a sex offender shall be subject to assessment utilizing the State Authorized Risk Assessment Tool for Sex Offenders (SARATSO), known as the "Static 99R" (Penal Code 290.04). Per Penal Code 290.06, Section 6, "Each probation department shall, prior to sentencing, assess every eligible person as defined in subdivision (c), whether or not a report is prepared pursuant to Section 1203." Section 7 states, "Each probation department shall assess every eligible person under its supervision who was not assessed pursuant to paragraph (6)."

Furthermore, the Coding Rules for the Static-99R state if an offender is offense free in the community for more than 10 years he is not eligible for re-scoring unless he has committed a new serious or violent offense, or new sex offense.

In Los Angeles County, the Static 99R assessment is conducted by the Pretrial Services Division (PTS). Upon receipt of the x-file, the Deputy Probation Officer (DPO) shall review the following Adult Probation Systems (APS) screens:

- **DCAD** to determine if the Static 99R score has been recorded and
- **DCID** to determine if PTS has recorded the score as well as made an entry indicating the assessment was conducted.

On all cases without a completed Static 99R, the DPO shall immediately forward the police report pertaining to the sex offense which resulted in the male offender being placed on probation, to Pretrial Services via e-mail or county mail:

Once PTS completes the assessment, the score will be scanned to the DPO of record and recorded in the APS DCAD and DCID screens.

All probationers with Static 99R scores of six (6) or higher are required to be placed on Global Positioning Satellite (GPS) monitoring (refer to Directive 1250). DPOs shall immediately refer probationers with high Static 99R scores to Sentinel Offender Services by completing and scanning the GPS Referral Form which is available on Probnet under Adult Forms.

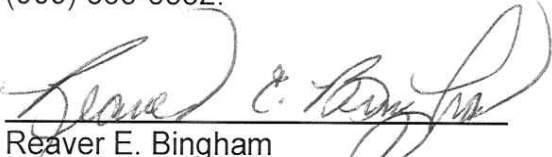
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The Supervising Deputy Probation Officer (SDPO) shall monitor the Sex Registrant (SRG) caseloads to ensure:

- Cases have been assessed with the Static 99R assessment tool
- Documentation is entered in DCID
- The Static 99R score has been entered in DCAD
- Cases are not transferred to other area offices unless the Static 99R assessment information is recorded in the APS DCID and DCAD screens.
