SUBJECT: Juvenile Forms Update (Conditions of Probation)

In an effort to provide Conditions of Probation that are clearly understood by the probationer, representatives from the Juvenile Court and Probation have amended the language of the conditions of probation.

This Directive provides instructions and information regarding the Minute Order-Conditions of Probation form 76M423A (Superior Court, Rev.10/2013).

For all investigation Pre-Plea/Disposition reports assigned effective **November 12, 2013**, DPOs shall use the court report probation template 1570 series that has the revised Minute Order-Conditions of Probation form (replaces Conditions of Probation form 1259) as indicated:

- Prob. 1570-R Suitable Placement recommendations (age <14)
- Prob. 1570-RO All recommendations except Suitable Placement
- Prob. 1570-RT Suitable Placement recommendations (age 14+)

Suitable Placement

- Prob. 1570-P Suitable Placement FF&E (age <14) – Placement only
- Prob. 1570-PT Suitable Placement FF &E (age 14+) – Placement only

Special Investigation Unit

- Prob. 1570-D 241.1 WIC – Suitable Placement recommendations (age<14)
- Prob. 1570-DT 241.1 WIC – Suitable Placement recommendations (age 14+)
- Prob. 1570-DO 241.1 WIC – All recommendations except Suitable Placement

Changes to the Juvenile Conditions of Probation include modifications to the wording for all conditions and in some instances the condition number has changed; for example,

Condition 15 – “You must not have any contact with or have someone else contact the victims or witnesses of any offense against you,” **replaces Condition 17** – “Do not contact or cause any contact with, nor associate with the victim(s) or witness(es) of any offense alleged against you,”

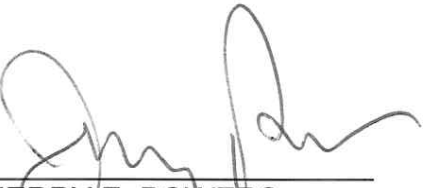
Condition 16 – “You must not be around any child who is younger than____, unless there is a responsible adult present,” **replaces Condition 18** – “Do not associate with children under____ years except in presence of a responsible adult,”

Condition 18 – “You must not be around persons you know to be users or sellers of illegal drugs or mind altering substances,” **replaces Condition 22** – “Do not associate with persons known to be users or sellers of narcotics/controlled substances, except with the prior written permission of the Probation Officer.”

The DPO shall ensure that the applicable condition is referenced and the appropriate box checked on the Conditions of Probation form (see the revised conditions of probation attachment).

The Juvenile Court Report Templates found in Probnet have been revised to reflect these instituted conditions of probation.

MINUTE ORDER – CONDITIONS OF PROBATION

- 1 ☐ You must not commit any crimes and you must follow the rules I am giving you.
- 1A ☐ You must obey all previous terms and conditions of probation given by any Judge, Commissioner or Referee, unless I have changed the conditions today.
- 2 ☐ You must obey the rules of your Parents, Caregivers, Teachers, School Officials, and Children's Services Workers.
- 3 ☐ You must obey the rules of your Probation Officer. You must meet your Probation Officer when told.
- 4 ☐ You must tell your Probation Officer before changing your phone number, where you live, where you attend school or work.
- 5 ☐ You must not leave Los Angeles County unless you first get permission from your Probation Officer, Parent or Caregiver.
- 6 ☐ You must not unlawfully threaten, hit, fight with, or use physical force on any person.
- 6A ☐ You must not engage in any sexual touching of any person.
- 7 ☐ You must not leave camp or placement without the permission of your Probation Officer. You must obey the rules of Camp or Placement.
- 8 ☐ You must complete _____ hours of Community Service.
- 8A ☐ You must complete _____ hours of Graffiti removal.
- 8B ☐ You must perform _____ days of Juvenile Alternative Work Service (JAWS).
- 9 ☐ You must go to school every day. You must be on time to each class. You must have good behavior at school. You must receive satisfactory grades.
- 9A ☐ You must participate in a high school diploma or GED program.
- 10 ☐ You must attend and participate in tutoring, vocational training, recreational activities or any other activities as directed by your caregiver or Probation Officer.
- 11 ☐ You must not be on the grounds of a school unless enrolled, attending classes, participating in school programs or with parent/caretaker.
- 12 ☐ You must follow the curfew set by your Probation Officer and your parent or caregiver. You must not be out of your home without your parent, or caregivers consent. Between the hours of _____ pm and 6 am you must be at home unless your parent or caregiver is present with you.
- 13 ☐ You must not associate or communicate with anyone you know your parent, caregiver or probation officer does not approve. You must not have someone else contact them for you.
- 13A ☐ Specifically no contact with _____.
- 13B ☐ You must not knowingly participate in any type of criminal street gang or illegal tagging activity. You must not knowingly associate with members of illegal tagging crews or criminal street gangs. You must not knowingly associate, communicate or be around criminal street gang members/illegal taggers from: _____.
- 13C ☐ You must stay away from the area defined as: _____.
- 14 ☐ You must not have, possess, or act like you possess a gun or knife, or possess any other object you know is a dangerous or deadly weapon. You also cannot have or possess anything you know that looks like a gun. You must not be around anyone you know to be unlawfully armed.
- 15 ☐ You must not have any contact with or have someone else contact the victims or witnesses of any offense against you.

- 16 ☐ You must not be around any child who is younger than _____, unless there is a responsible adult present.
- 17 ☐ You must not knowingly drink or possess any alcoholic beverages nor knowingly use or possess illegal drugs or mind altering substances except as prescribed by a physician.
- 18 ☐ You must not be around persons you know to be users or sellers of illegal drugs or mind altering substances.
- 19 ☐ You must give a sample of your urine to test for drugs or alcohol whenever asked.
- 20 ☐ You must be randomly tested by Probation for Drugs and Alcohol a minimum of _____ times per month.
- 21 ☐ You must permit a law enforcement officer to search your person, house or property at any time of the day or night with or without a warrant.
- 22 ☐ You must pay to the victim for any injuries or damages you caused in the amount of \$ _____, plus a Probation service charge.
- 23 ☐ You must pay to the victim for any damages to him/her or his/her property that you or your companions caused by committing this crime. The amount you owe, if any, will be determined by your Probation Officer, subject to court approval.
