SUBJECT: POST-RELEASE SERVICES (AB 109) BUREAU MANUAL POLICIES – DETENTION & ARREST POLICY (PRS-514); SUPERVISION OF CASES INVOLVING DOMESTIC VIOLENCE/SPECIAL VICTIMS (PRS-526); AND SUPERVISION OF CLIENTS WITH CO-OCCURRING DISORDERS (PRS-528)

The following sections of the AB 109 Bureau Manual have been approved for distribution. Staff assigned to support the AB 109 Bureau are instructed to review the attached policies. The following new/revised policies are to be incorporated into the AB 109 Manual, which is currently in progress:

 - Victim Contacts & Notifications
 - Violation of Conditions of Supervision
3. The Supervision of Clients with Co-Occurring Disorders (PRS-528) policy, which includes the following sections:
 - Introduction
 - Identification & Referral
 - Supervision
 - Collaboration
 - Co-Occurring Residential Programs
 - Narcotics Testing
 - Strength-Based Case Management & Case Plans
 - Multidisciplinary Treatment Team Meetings
